The Tri-County Regional Planning Commission (TCRPC) announced today that copies of the draft 2011-2014 Transportation Improvement Program for Clinton, Eaton and Ingham Counties is available for public review and comment prior to action by the Commission to adopt the 2011-2014 Transportation Improvement Program at their meeting on June 23, 2010.

Copies of the draft Transportation Improvement Program may be obtained by contacting the Commission offices at 913 W. Holmes Road, Suite 201, Lansing, MI 48910, or by calling (517) 393-0342. In addition, the document is posted on the agency website at www.mitrpc.org.

The 2011-2014 Transportation Improvement Program identifies proposed airport, highway and public transit improvement projects to be completed in the region between 2011 and 2014. Cost of proposed projects identified in the document total over \$306 million dollars, including nearly \$102 million dollars in federal transportation funds.

Examples of local projects proposed for completion in FY 2011 include:

- Approximately \$525,000 to resurface Jolly Road in Lansing from Aurelius to Dunkel.

- Approximately \$1.1 million to reconstruct Harrison Road in East Lansing from Mt. Hope to Trowbridge.
- Approximately \$630,000 to widen Waverly from 2 to 3 lanes from Miller to Jolly in Ingham County.
- Approximately \$870,000 to reconstruct St. Joe Highway from Canal to Broadbent in Eaton County.
- Approximately \$1 million dollars to replace the Herbison Road bridge over the Looking Glass River in Clinton County.
- Approximately \$147,000 in funding for CATA to replace three buses.
