- ACTION I. Call to Order/Introductions/Minutes  
Minutes for the February 1, 2011 meeting are enclosed.
- ACTION II. TIP Amendments
- A. Waverly Road Sidewalk Project – The City of Lansing requests an amendment to the illustrative list (enclosed). This project will connect Moores River Dr. to Grand River Park North. Support from the Ingham County Road Commission and the YMCA of Metropolitan Lansing is enclosed. CARTS is asked to recommend action to the TRC.
- B. Michigan Avenue Extension – The Eaton County Road Commission requests an amendment to the Michigan Avenue extension project costs by moving funding and modifying the Eaton County St. Joe Rd. project description to shorten the project. CARTS is asked to recommend action to the TRC.
- III. Title VI Requirements for Federal Aid Recipients  
Cheryl Hudson, MODT's EEO Officer, Title VI and ADA Coordinator, will present on requirements that affect all federal fund recipients.
- IV. Michigan Avenue/Grand River Corridor Study  
CATA staff will present results of the Michigan Avenue/Grand River Corridor Study. A draft amendment to the Regional 2035 Transportation Plan and 2011-2014 TIP are enclosed for your review. It will be presented for action at the May meeting. Drafts are provided now for discussion.
- V. Status of Projects  
Committee members will report on the status of 2011 Urban STP and CMAQ projects.
- VI. Discuss Possible Three-Year TIP Cycle  
MDOT initiated discussion with FHWA and MPOs to temporarily extend the TIP cycle to three years. This would push development of a new TIP to June of 2013. This approach has advantages and disadvantages to consider. Staff will brief CARTS and discuss the implications.
